To Him be glory both now and forever! Amen."

Academics

Our students engage in an academic program following both the Concordia Curriculum Guide and the Nebraska State Standards. The Concordia Curriculum Guide helps us to integrate the faith in all subjects throughout the day.

Students are tested to gauge their academic progress using the NWEA Measures of Academic Progress each fall and spring. The MAPS results are summarized in the table found below.

Service

Throughout the school year ILS students put into action our school theme of "Growing in Christ!" Our students gathered chapel offerings to help Camp Luther of Nebraska, the Garuna Kids Mission, the Global Kids Fund in Zambia, and the Orphan Grain Train.

ILS Middle School students have a special service time, weekly, to complete servant events in school and around the community. Some events include the following: reading with younger students, cleanup inside and outside, fall cleanup, making cards for homebound community members, helping setup for the Extravaganza and VIP day, and stuffing bags for the Run for the Risen Son.

ILS band students played for residents at a local nursing home. The 2nd graders made care bags to donate to the CCH Hematology and Oncology department. Multiple lower grades worked together to clean up litter in a local public park.

Activities

ILS was able to resume most of our normal school year activities. ILS held a Christmas Concert for the community in December and performed the spring musical *The Agape League* in April. The Extravaganza, held in November, is the auction event to raise tuition assistance for ILS. Run for the Risen Son, the Saturday before Easter, is a fun family run for the community. ILS participates in Lutheran Field Day in May. Students get to compete against local Lutheran schools in track and field events.
